

The Land Between is a globally rare ecoregion between the Canadian Shield and the St. Lawrence Lowlands containing 59 federally listed Species-At-Risk. It provides water and other ecosystem services but is affected by population growth and climate change. The Land Between is also the name of the non-profit organization founded by Leora Berman in 2006.

Leora has been leading and developing large scale ecological projects for nonprofit groups and governments for almost 25 years. Leora is the 2019 recipient of the Canada Wildlife Federation, Roland Michener Award for outstanding achievements in wildlife research and conservation.
